

Transportation Improvements



The Hollywood Park Tomorrow project team plans to implement dozens of improvements to key local intersections and street segments in the area that will ease existing traffic flow, making it easier for Inglewood residents to drive through the community. Traffic signal synchronization and street widening will completely mitigate the project’s impacts and improve existing traffic flow in the City.

The traffic study included in the EIR analyzed 66 separate intersections in the vicinity of Hollywood Park Tomorrow. Using methodology from the City of Inglewood, the EIR found that six intersections would be impacted by the project if no improvements were made.

As a result, the project team plans to complete street widening and traffic signal upgrades along Prairie Avenue and Century Boulevard to accommodate existing and future traffic. In addition, Hollywood Park Tomorrow will provide full funding for a traffic signal synchronization network at 19 key intersections in the City of Inglewood, which can improve traffic flow by up to 15%.

Furthermore, the Hollywood Park Tomorrow team will assist with the funding of future identified improvements in the area on a fair share basis.

Hollywood Park Tomorrow's pedestrian-friendly format will also help to reduce vehicle dependence within the community. Paths and paseos that weave throughout the three residential neighborhoods will encourage residents to walk and leave their cars behind. Additionally, pedestrian connections will be provided from Hollywood Park Tomorrow to major transit corridors on Century Boulevard and Prairie Avenue and new, updated traffic signals will help ensure the safety of people who choose to walk, not drive.

Finally, Hollywood Park Tomorrow will produce less traffic compared to other developments by providing a mix of entertainment, restaurants, homes and parks all within close proximity of each other and existing transportation routes.
